The Irvine Scholars Program Instructions

Before beginning the application process, please read the entire application packet. Applications are accepted year-round but must be submitted at least 1 month prior to the semester start date. An Application for Admission must be submitted with the Scholarship application to be eligible.

The Irvine Scholars Program

Description:

The Irvine Scholars Program is intended to promote high academic achievement and community involvement among new entering students in our law, business, and TESOL programs. Under the Irvine Scholars Program, a select group of students will come to Irvine University to embark on an integrated educational experience designed to provide the best of the university and its student support services. Irvine Scholars will be educated to become academic scholars as well as community leaders. Based on academic excellence and leadership potential, students selected as Irvine Scholars receive:

- Full or partial tuition scholarships
- Comprehensive 1-on-1 mentoring and leadership development by a Senior faculty member
- Waived registration to special workshops and programs for Irvine Scholars.

Scholarship Requirements:

To be eligible for this award, applicants must have completed at least 60 semester units or received a Bachelor's degree at a U.S. accredited college with an undergraduate grade point average of at least 3.0 on a scale of 4.0. Each scholarship recipient will be awarded up to \$10,000 per year.

Unless exceptional circumstances exist, scholarship recipients are required to achieve and maintain a 3.0 or better cumulative grade point average each semester during the school year. Recipients must also maintain 90% attendance for three consecutive semesters during the school year. Failure to maintain the 3.0 G.P.A. and attendance requirements will result in the automatic and permanent forfeiture of the scholarship award.

Criterion:

The Scholarship Committee selects recipients from application's personal statements addressing their background, achievements & community involvement. Previous academic performance is a major criterion.
